MONDAY, DECEMBER 19th, 1938.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, December 19th, 1938, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the resignation of Abbie E. Hoyle, Nurse at the colored municipal hospital, be and the same is hereby accepted as of December 7th, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that Alma Williams, be and she is hereby appointed Nurse at the colored municipal hospital, as of December 7th, 1938, at a salary of \$65.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following affidavits of erroneous assessment approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, be and the same are hereby approved:

And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue certificates of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavits of erroneous assessment filed by Mary C. and Pearl M. Alexander covering the last half of taxes on various realestate for the year 1932, be and the same are hereby denied for the reason that one-half of taxes has been paid and the County Treasurer has heretofore refused to accept certificates of error on a half year. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Exception taken and notice of appeal given.
