

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County owns a 1940 Chevrolet Truck, Serial Number 5WB10-2071, Motor Number T-2773808, that was used by the Highway Department, and

WHEREAS, said Truck being in a state of bad repair and not generally servicable for the uses and purposes of the Highway Department, in which it is being used, having been purchased and paid for from County funds, the Board of County Commissioners authorized the sale of said Chevrolet truck to the highest bidder, and

WHEREAS, Gower Motor Company was the successful bidder in the amount of Four Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$425.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to transfer title to the aforesaid 1940 Chevrolet Truck to the highest bidder.
