PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, acting for and on behalf and in the name of said County be authorized and empowered to incur an indebtedness by issuing negotiable coupon bonds in the aggregate principal of Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of providing funds to purchase lands, improve the same and to construct buildings thereon for free fair purposes, the same to be owned and controlled by said Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, said bonds to bear interest at the rate not to exceed six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and such bonds shall be issued in denominations of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or any multiple thereof, not to exceed One Thousand (\$1,000.00) and the entire amount of said bond issue shall be payable within twenty five years from the date thereof, and shall be made to mature in annual installments beginning in not less than three (3) years, nor more than five (5) after their date, and said bonds to be known as "Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Free Fair Bonds of 1930", and authorizing and empowering the officers of said Tulsa County, charged by law with levying taxes for County purposes to levy annually an amount sufficient to pay the interest due each year on the bonds issued, and in addition thereto, levy an amount sufficient to pay the principal of said bonds as the same falls due, said levies to be in addition to all other taxes levied in said County for County purposes.
