The Petition of the Texas Co.

Order of Commissioners

The appointments of J. J. Moran, O. P. Marshall, & Pleas Gagee was on motion accepted
 To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,
 The Petitioner, The Texas Co. would respectfully represent and show to your Honorable
 Board; that it is a corporation, duly authorized and existing under the laws of
 the State of Oklahoma for the production, purchase and transportation of crude
 petroleum. That said Company is engaged in the business of purchasing and
 transporting crude petroleum in the State of Oklahoma. That it is desirous
 of conducting its said business in the County of Tulsa, and it will be necessary
 to construct various lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire along and
 across the highways of said County. Wherefore, your Petitioner would respectfully
 request that it be permitted to lay, maintain and operate and remove lines
 of pipe and telegraph wire for the conveyance of crude oil or petroleum, along
 and across any of the public highways of Tulsa County, where the same
 may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe and wire,
 under such rules and regulations, as may be necessary in the judgment
 of your Honorable Board, for the protection and preservation of said highways,
 and so as to avoid any inconvenience to the public in the use of same,
 as well as the protection of said County against liability for damages, by
 reason of the construction, maintenance and operation of the same,

 Now on this 15 day of Oct. 1908, at a regular meeting called in compliance
 of and according to law, of said Board of County Commissioners,
 comes the Texas Company, as Company and presents to the said
 Board its request in writing, setting forth that it is necessary for the
 purpose of carrying on its business of purchasing and transporting
 crude petroleum, as in said petition stated, to lay and remove construct
 and maintain lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire along
 and across the public highways of said Tulsa County, and said Board,
 being fully advised in the matter and having carefully considered
 the same it is hereby ordered that the said Texas Co. be and it is hereby
 permitted to lay, maintain and remove and operate lines of pipe and
 telegraph or telephone wire for the conveyance of crude oil along and across
 any of the public highways in said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, where the
 same may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be buried so as not to inter-
 fere with ingress or egress to adjacent farm at the ordinary places of entrance,
 and at such other places along such highways where the abutting land owner
 may desire to locate a place for entrance, when so requested, by said owner.
