Monday, May 4, 1914.

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met in regular session at Eight Thirty, A. M. All members present. Board proceeded to audit claims against the county.

Moved by Mr. Wooley, seconded by Mr. Baker, that One Thousand Detention Dollars (\$1000.00) be allowed the next fiscal year for purchasing a detention Home home and hospital for sick babies, conditional on the law premitting same. Motion prevailed.
