The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner W L North, who moved its adoption. The motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by Commissioner Ed W Hedgecock, and the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY CLERK OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE SALE OF CERTAIN BOND ISSUES OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, AS DESCRIBED IN THE BODY HEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County Election Board of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has certified to this Board its Certificates and canvass of returns of the special election held throughout Tulsa County Oklahoma, the 4th. day of November, 1930, on the proposition, to-wit:

"SHALL the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, acting for and on behalf and in the name of said County be authorized and empowered to incur an indebtedness by issuing negotiable coupon bonds in the aggregate principal of Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars, for the purpose of providing funds to purchase lands, improve the same, and to construct buildings thereon for free fair purposes, the same to be owned and controlled by said Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, said bonds to bear interest at the rate not to exceed six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and such bonds shall be issued in denominations of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or any multiple thereof, not to exceed One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and the entire amount of said bond issue shall be payable within twenty five years from the date thereof, and shall be made to mature in annual installments beginning in not less than three (3) years, nor more than five (5) years, after their date, and said bonds to be known as "Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Free Fair Bonds of 1930", and authorizing and empowering the officers of said Tulsa County, charged by law with levying taxes for County purposes to levy annually an amount sufficient to pay
