In the matter of laying of certain pipelines along, under and across certain high ways, the following Order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, on this 1st. day of May, 1933, the matter of the petition of Maggie Cunningham and Archie Tadder, co-partners, doing business as Cunningham and Tadder, for permission to lay certain pipe lines along, under and across certain highways in said County And State, came before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it would be to the advantage of the County of Tulsa and inhabitants of the district hereinafter described that the said Cunningham and Tadder, their successors and assigns, be permitted touse as much of the highways as is designated by a plat filed with the Petition of said Cunningham and Tadder, and more particularly described as follows:

All of the highways, streets,,avenues, alleys and other public ways being in the area bounded on the North by the North line of 41st.Street; on the West by the West line of South Peoria Avenue; on the South by the South line of 71st.Street, and on the East by t e East line of Lewis Avenue; also certain portions of the following streets lying outside of but adjacent to said area; 71st.Street; Quincy Avenue; 51st.Street; 54th.Street 55th.Street; 60th.Street; 61st.Street; Newport Avenue, Owasso Avenue and Madison Avenue, so called, all as shown upon theplat attached thereto as an Exhibit for the purpose of laying gas pipe lines.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipelines have been constructed so as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of the highways, and inaccordance with all of the rules and regulations ofthe County Commissionersandthe laws of the State of Oklahoma governing the same.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED BY THE BOARD of County Commissioners of Tulsa County,Oklahoma, that permission be, and the same is hereby granted to MAGGIE CUNNINGHAM and ARCHIE TADDER, co-partners, doing business under the name and style of CUNNINGHAM AND TADDER, their successors and assigns, touse as muchmof the streets and highways of Tulsa County as are contained within the area above described and as are shown upon the plat attached hereto, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining pipe lines thereon.
