

that the same shall revert back to the control of the TULSA STATE FAIR BOARD; and GRANTEE'S rights terminate therein; it is further stipulated and agreed between the parties hereto that in the event the TULSA STATE FAIR and the INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM EXPOSITION, are not held on the same dates, then in such event, the TULSA STATE FAIR shall have access to and the right to the use of the rest rooms and toilets thereon, and Red Cross Hospital, when built, during exhibition of the TULSA STATE FAIR, and entrances be provided for the use of same from State Fair Grounds to rest rooms, by the INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM EXPOSITION.

It is further stipulated and agreed between the parties hereto that during the exhibition of the Tulsa State Fair, that no livestock, animals, cattle or poultry of any kind or character shall be maintained or kept, on the plat of ground herein granted by the same shall be kept as a lawn and set to flowers, shrubbery and shade trees; that this license and privilege shall not be assigned without the written consent of the TULSA STATE FAIR DIRECTORS, and is granted without consideration other than hereinabove expressed, in order to aid, assist and promote the success of both the TULSA STATE FAIR and the INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM EXPOSITION.

It is further stipulated between the parties hereto that each party shall co-operate with the other, to prevent any accident, damage or injury to person or property on said premises during the progress of either the TULSA STATE FAIR or the INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM EXPOSITION; it is expressly agreed that reasonable precautions shall be taken to prevent damage by fire to the improvements; that during the time each of the respective parties hereto have access to and the use of the premises herein granted, that they shall pay all costs of attendants, water, light heat or gas which may be used at, on or in any of the improvements; under the direction and supervision of the Superintendent of the Grantee.

Said Grantee expressly covenants and agrees to conform to and abide by, and not violate any Federal, State or County, Municipal Law, Sanitary or Health Regulation, nor knowingly consent or allow any violation of the Gambling laws of the State of Oklahoma, upon said grounds during the period of this license.

This License shall enure to the benefit and be binding upon the successors of the parties hereto, provided, however, same shall not be transferred nor assigned by said second party without the written consent of the first party, endorsed in writing hereon.
