

The Petition of Oklahoma Co.

To, the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Of Tulsa Co., State of Oklahoma,
 The Petitioner, The Oklahoma Co., would respectfully represent and show, unto your Honorable Board that it is a corporation duly existing under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, for the production purchase and transportation of crude petroleum. That said company is engaged in the business of purchasing and transportation of crude petroleum in the State of Oklahoma. That it is desirous of constructing its said business in the Co of Tulsa, and it will be necessary to construct various lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire along and across the highways of said County. Wherefore, your Petitioners would respectfully request that it be permitted to lay maintain and operate, and remove lines of pipe and telegraph wire for the conveyance of crude oil or petroleum, along and across any of the public highways of Tulsa Co., where the same may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe and wire under such rules and regulations as may be necessary in the judgement of your Honorable Board, for the protection and preservation of said highways, and so as to avoid any inconvenience to the public in the use of same, as well, as the protection of said County against liability for damages, by reason of the construction, maintenance and operation of the same.

Now on this 15 day of Oct. 1908, at a regular meeting called in compliance of and according to law, of said Board of County Commissioners, comes The Oklahoma Company and presents to the said Board its request, in writing, setting forth that it is necessary for the purpose of carrying on its business of purchasing crude petroleum, as in said petition stated, to lay construct and maintain and remove lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire along and across the public highways of said Tulsa Co., and said Board being fully advised in the matter and having carefully considered the same, it is hereby ordered that the said The Oklahoma Company, be and it is hereby permitted to lay maintain and operate and remove lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire for the conveyance of crude oil along and across any of the public highways in said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, where the same may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be buried so as not to interfere with ingress or egress to adjacent farms at the ordinary places of entrance and at such other places along such highways where the abutting land-owners may desire to locate a place for entrance when so requested by said owner.
