Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the salaries of Dr. W. T. Napier; Dr. B. A. Waynes, Nola Moore and Willia Jones Ward be increased \$5.00 each per month as of February 1st, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
