

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

WHEREAS, it further appearing that the owners of Lots 1 and 8 in Block 5, and Lot 1 in Block 8, and Lot 13 in Block 4 of Garden City, accoring to the recorded plat thereof, in the said Section 23, Township 19, Range 12 East, are willing to donate the said property for a public highway. And, it further appearing that a strip of property necessary for the said road, immediately South of the Half section Line of said Section 23, Township 19, Range 12 East, that is, and South of the Railroad of the Brach Line of the Midland Valley Railroad Company, has also been donated for highway purposes; that the said strip extends West to the Section Line or the County Road intersection.

WHEREAS, the owners of the land traversed having donated the same and the parties have designated the County Engineer to represent them and proceed to locate the said road.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the County Commissioners hereby accept the land above mentioned, as donated for the establishing of a public highway, and that the same is hereby accepted.

AND, FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the road hereby established is for the best interest of all parties concerned, and that the same furnishes the relief as prayed for in the petition heretofore filed.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer be hereby instructed to locate the said road to the best advantage of all parties concerned.
