R E S O L U T I O N

Be it remembered that at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held at the courthouse in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 18 day of Jan, 1936, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by said Board of County Commissioners, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma has agreed to submit to the Secretary of Agriculture, a project for the improvement of 7.976 miles of the Secondary Highway from the Section Corner to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, T 19 N, R 13 E, to the Section Corner to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T 19 N, R 14 E. with funds apportioned to the State under Section 204 of the National Industrial Recovery Act, and

WHEREAS, the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, desires that such improvement be made and does agree to maintain said highway in a manner satisfactory to the State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma after its improvements, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County be and he is hereby, authorized and empowered to enter into and execute a contract and agreement with said State Highway Commission carrying out the purposes of this resolution.

Adopted this 18 day of January, 1936, by the unanimous vote of said Board of County Commissioners.
