Be it resolved that the Resolution passed by this Board of County Commissioners on on August 21, 1950 authorizing the issuance of bonds of Water Improvement District No. 19 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to pay the cost of construction of the public distribution system of said district be amended so as to provide that the bond interest coupon shall be issued in two series, one for four percent (4%) and once for two percent (2%) in lieu of one series for six percent (6%); and that the provisions for the two series of coupons shall be recided in the bonds as issued.
