

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

Warden Co., Oklahoma City

Description of road:

Beginning at a point on the N. & S. section line, 1815.2 feet South of the N. E. corner of Section 32, Twp. 19 N., R. 12 E., Tulsa Co., Oklahoma, which point is 172.8 ft. north of the center line of the St. L. & S. F. R.R.; running thence S. 46 degrees 20' W., a distance of 1874.5 ft., parallel to the center line of said R.R., and 125 ft. distant therefrom; thence in a southwesterly direction 1660 ft., paralleling the center line of said R. R., and 125 ft. distant therefrom; thence S. 8 degrees 00' E., a distance of 250 ft., crossing over the South side of said R.R.; thence in a Southwesterly direction 230 ft., paralleling the center line of said R.R., and 125 ft distant therefrom; thence S. 85 degrees W., 320 feet paralleling the center line of said R.R., and 125 ft. distant therefrom; thence in a Southwesterly direction 1435 ft. paralleling the center line of said R. R., and 125 ft. distant therefro; thence S. 70 degrees 15' W. 1625 ft. paralleling the center line of said R.R., and 125 ft. distant therefrom to where said line intersects the south side of sec. 31, tp. 19 N., R. 12 E.,

Said road to be 25' wide on each side of the center line, or a total width of 50 ft.

Description of road:

Commencing at a point where the A. V. & W. Railroad crosses the Tulsa County in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 6, Twp. 19, Range 10 East, I. M., thence running Southwest along the South side of Railroad right of way to a point where said railroad crosses the County line.

John D. Porter, as assignee, filed demand for refund of taxes paid on sundry Indian Homesteads, asper demand on file in the office of the County Clerk. Upon motion same disallowed.
