WHEREAS, The Tulsa County Highway Department has been made an offer by Mr. C. W. Venable, Bixby, Oklahoma, of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for the purchase of same,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that, since we have been unsuccessful in all attempts to get someone to remove this bridge from the Creek bed, that the above offer of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) made by Mr. Venable, be accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.
