In the matter of the Petition of Cosden Pipe Line Company, asking permission to lay a pipe line along certain highways, the following Order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, On this 2nd. day of July, 1928, the matter of the petition of Cosden Pipe Line Company for permission to lay a pipe line under, through and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said Cosden Pipe Line Company be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

"Beginning at a point on the North Right of Way line of the highway 202 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 24, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and running South a distance of 60 feet under, through and across the right of way and pavement of the highway at a point on the South right of way line 202 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 25, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, a proposed three inch oil pipe line encased with 63 feet of 6 inch casing, and is definitely located on the blue print map hereto attached and made a part hereof.
