

November 6, 1944

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the transfer of Bryan Custer from Patrol Operator to Shovel Operator, County Highway Department, District #3, at a salary of \$185.00 per month, effective November 1, 1944, replacing Frank Lewis, Shovel Operator, who resigned be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that upon the recommendation of the Tulsa County Election Board, that the salaries of B. J. Burke, Nora Adams, Estelle Timmons, Noweta Adams and Dick Tollison be increased \$25.00 each per month for the months of October and November 1944, on account of the great amount of extra overtime they worked during the November 7th Election. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Commissioner Greer, "AYE"; Commissioner Gray, "AYE"; Commissioner Kinkaid "NO". Motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The following Resolution was presented by Commissioner Kinkaid:

"That the Election Board be advised of the Law pertaining to employes of Tulsa County, their wives, or other immediate relatives working on the Election Board, and, if the Board of County Commissioners finds that this condition exists, the Election Board be notified to make a change immediately.

Resolution died for want of a second.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that upon the recommendation of A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff of Tulsa County, that the appointment of Maurice E. Gibson as deputy sheriff at a salary of \$175.00 per month, effective November 1, 1944, replacing Elmer Orr, who resigned, be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray that the Bond filed by Everett L. Terrill, in the amount of \$1,000.00 and written by the Ohio Casualty Insurance Company, beand the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
