To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County,  
 State of Oklahoma,

Now, on this the 10 day of November, 1908, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, held according to law, comes Charles Page and presents to the said Board his request in writing set forth that it is necessary for the purpose of carrying on his business of producing and transporting crude petroleum and natural gas as in said petition stated to lay, construct and maintain lines of pipe and telephone wires along and across the public highways of the said Tulsa County, And said Board being fully advised in the matter and having carefully considered the same it is hereby ordered that the said Charles Page, his heirs, administrators or assigns be and hereby are permitted to maintain and operate telephone wires and is hereby permitted to lay, maintain and operate lines of pipe for the conveyance of crude petroleum and natural gas along and across all of the public highways in said Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma where the same may be necessary for the construction of his said lines of pipe and telephone wires incident and necessary to the sale and production of crude petroleum and natural gas;

It is further ordered that the said lines of pipe shall be operated so as not to interfere with the ingress and egress to adjacent farms at the original place of entrances and at such other places along said highways, where the abutting land-owners may desire to locate and place for entrances when so requested by said owners.

It is understood that in granting this order that it shall not in any way be construed as assuming any responsibility on the part of the Board of County Commissioners of the said Tulsa County or any part of said County.

The said Charles Page, his heirs, administrators or assigns shall be responsible for all damages done in constructing said lines of pipe or said telephone wires or which in any wise may be caused or occasioned by the use of the same.

It is further agreed and understood that the said lines of pipe shall be used only for the transportation of crude petroleum or natural gas.
