

secured and granted thereby, shall in no wise abridge the rights and authorities of the County Commissioners, of the Township Trustees and the Road Overseers of the public highways in said County, as the same is provided by law.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe or telephone wires shall be so laid and constructed as not to interfere with the use of any of the said public highways.

It is further ordered that any pipe or telephone lines parallel with section lines they shall be laid and constructed as near the outside lines of highways as possible and in no case shall they encroach on the inside line of the highways more than three feet without first getting permission from the ^{County} Commissioners so to do.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe hereby laid shall be constructed so as not to interfere with the drainage of the highways and in crossing dams or streams shall be placed above or below same so as not to obstruct the flow of water therein.

It being distinctly understood that no connections shall be made whereby any gas may be piped or conducted out of the state of Oklahoma,
