

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

BE-IT-RESOLVED

SOLVED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF TULSA, STATE OF OKLAHOMA,

Section 1. That for the purpose of funding a like amount of the legal, outstanding judgment indebtedness of the County ~~and~~ of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, mentioned in the preamble hereof, there shall be, and there are hereby authorized and directed to be, issued the negotiable coupon bonds of said County of Tulsa in accordance with the forms hereinafter provided, to an amount aggregating the principal sum of \$14,000.00

And the County clerk of said County of Tulsa, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed by publication in the Tulsa Daily Democrat, a newspaper published at the City of Tulsa, the county seat of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, and of general circulation in said County, and by posting in at least five (5) public places in said County to give public notice that the County of Tulsa, by its proper officers, will, on the 15th day of August, 1914, at 9 o'clock A. M., proceed before the Superior court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and then and there, or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, make a showing, offer proof, and ask the Court to hear and determine the existence, character, and amount of outstanding legal judgment indebtedness of said County of Tulsa, and sign the bonds to be issued in payment of the same, at which time and place any and all persons interested may appear and remonstrate against the issuance of said bonds; which notice shall be substantially the following form, to-wit:

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO FUNDS.

Notice is hereby given, that on the 15th day of August, 1914, at 9 o'clock A. M., or as soon thereafter as a hearing may be had, the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, by its proper officers will proceed before the Superior Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to make a showing and offer proof and ask said Court to hear and determine the existence, character, and amount of its legal outstanding judgment indebtedness, and to sign the bonds to be issued in payment of said.

All persons interested may be present at the time said proof is made to remonstrate against the issuance of said bonds.

Section 2. That said bonds shall be designated "Funding bonds of 1914", shall be fourteen in number, numbered from One to Fourteen, both inclusive, and of the following denominations, to-wit: Bonds numbered One to Fourteen inclusive, shall be in the sum of One Thousand Dollars each; they shall bear the date of August 3 A. D. 1914, and shall become due and payable on August 3, A. D. 1915; they shall bear interest from their date until paid at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, payable annually on the 3rd day of August A. D. 1915, which installments of interest to date of maturity of principal shall be evidenced by appropriate coupons attached to each bond; and both
