to the Board of County Commissioners o f the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an
application for the issuance to J G HUGHES, Receiver for First National Bank, Bixby, of
a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars the following describ
