Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that the resignation of Jewel W. Bryan in the Court Clerk's office, effective October 1, 1950, be and the same is hereby accepted. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioners Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, that the following claims that were disallowed on July 31, 1950, now be allowed as funds are available to pay these claims: #8394 Flower Hospital - \$262.30; Claim #8416 Medical Arts Laboratories - \$25.00 and Claim #8456 - Hollister-Stier Laboratories for \$20.36. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried that George G. Briggs be appointed Minute Clerk in Division No. 2, effective October 1, 1950, at a salary of \$225.00 replacing Robert D. Simms who resigned. Also that the appointment of W. H. Wards as a Deputy in the Court Clerk's office effective October 1, 1950 at a salary of \$200.00 per month be approved. Mr. Wards is replacing Jewel Bryan.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried that upon the recommendation of the Extension Division of the Oklahoma A and M College Mr. Vance Scott be appointed County Agent of Tulsa County, effective November 1, 1950 to fill the vacancy created by the death of O. J. Moyer.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried, that Mr. Scott be given a \$30.00 per month car allowance and salary of \$209.50 per month.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried that the report filed by the Court Clerk for the District Court Division, for the month of August, 1950, be accepted and filed.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried that the Memorandum of Agreement for Extension work Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College and the Board of County Commissioner of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the period of July 1, 1950 to June 30, 1951, be and the same is hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried that upon the recommendation of the Tulsa County Medical Society Dr. J. Jeff Billington be placed on a full time basis at the County Clinic at a salary of \$700.00 per month.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Couch and unanimously carried that Claim #1546 filed by the Fifteenth Street Paint and Body Works in the amount of \$70.70 covering damages to a 48 Dodge sedan when struck by a County Truck, be and the same is hereby disallowed.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that H. C. Walden, Building Superintendent be and he is hereby authorized to move the County Election Board where the Engineer's office is, and to move the County Engineer's office into the rooms vacated by the Juvenile Court.
