KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the County of Tulsa, of the State of Oklahoma, hereby acknowledges itself indebted to and for value received promises to pay to the bearer the sum of One Thousand Dollars, on the 3rd day of August, A. D. 1915, together with interest thereon from the date hereof until paid at the rate of six (6) per cent per annum, payable annually on the 3rd day of August A.D. 1915; said interest evidenced by and to be paid upon the surrender of the coupons hereto attached as they severally become due, both principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the office of the County Treasurer of the County of Tulsa, in the City of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma.

This bond is one of a series, numbered from One to Fourteen, of like date and tenor x x x x x x x x x x x x x x aggregating the principal sum of \$14,000.00, and is issued for the purpose of funding the legal outstanding judgment indebtedness of said County, under Sections 362-375, both inclusive, Revised Laws of Oklahoma, 1910, and other Statutes of the State of Oklahoma, supplementary and amendatory thereto.

The full faith, credit and resources of said County of Tulsa are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payment of this bond.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done, happened and been performed in regular and due form as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of said County, including this bond, and the series of which it forms a part does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation, and that due provision has been made for the collection of an annual tax sufficient to pay the interest on this bond as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal hereof at maturity.
