The Board of County Commissioners reconvened, pursuant to recess heretofore taken, at the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that the article presented by the Tulsa County Clinic Committee in the form of a letter be accepted and that we proceed to work in accordance with it. Motion seconded by Commissioner Shepard, and upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, pass. Motion carried.

Mr. Sallee: I do not think it is good business on the part of the County Commissioners on the eve of election to agree to turn over approximately \$96,000 to the Tulsa County Medical Society to be used for the clinic without first having studied the budget and worked out the needs of the clinic for the next year. I am willing to co-operate with the Clinic and work to the best interests of the tax-payers of Tulsa County but I don't think this should be disposed of one day before election.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that a recess be taken until Wednesday, July 10th, 1940, at the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
