MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 8th, 1941.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, member. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the resolution adopted on July 7th, 1941, Re: Order/^{ing}Mrs. Rose Gwin to vacate that part and portion of the basement of the Courthouse occupied by her as a concession and lunch-room and turning same over to Mrs. C. M. Lassiter, be and the same is hereby rescinded. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the concession in the basement of the Courthouse be leased to the Adult Blind Commission for the sale of soft drinks, cigars, candy, etc., (No cooking); term of said lease to be worked out with the Board of County Commissioners and the Adult Blind Commission. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that \$1,000 be allocated to Q-16. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
