The following Special Election proclamation is hereby ordered to be published by the Board of County Commissioners, as required by law:

SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION.

Proclamation is hereby given that under and by virtue of section 26, Article 10 of the Constitution of Oklahoma, and Article 1, Chapter 73 of the Revised Laws of Oklahoma, 1910, as amended by Chapter 22, Session Laws of Oklahoma, 1916, and laws supplementary and amendatory thereto, and resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 15th day of October, 1917, an election will be held in said County on the 20th day of November, 1917, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said County the following proposition:

SHALL THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF TULSA BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE NEGOTIABLE COUPON BONDS OF SAID COUNTY IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$ 1,750,000.00) DOLLARS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RAISING FUNDS FOR BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTING PERMANENT STATE ROADS IN SAID COUNTY OF TULSA, SAID BONDS TO RUN FROM ONE TO TWENTY FIVE YEARS FROM DATE THEREOF, BEARING INTEREST AT THE RATE OF
