ASKING THE CITY OF TULSA TO ANNEX THAT PART OF RIVERSIDE DRIVE LYING NORTH OF THIRTY FIRST STREET AND SOUTH OF THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, that portion of Riverside Drive lying north of Thirty First Street and South of the present City Limits, is out of the City of Tulsa and in the County of Tulsa

AND WHEREAS, Tulsa County procured this property for highway purposes under District Court Case No. 62680 on the 20th day of October, 1936

AND WHEREAS, Tulsa County, on the 21st day of October, 1936, issued to the Consolidated Construction Company Claim No. 5820 in the amount of \$2,500.00; and on the 30th day of June, 1937, on Claim No. 7449 paid to the Consolidated Construction Company the balance in the amount of \$1,139.25 for the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 24.75 feet North and 82.20 feet West of the South Quarter corner of Section 13, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, running thence North 89°48' West along the North right of way line of County Highway a distance of 81.70 feet to pa a point, thence North 11°218 West a distance of 471.90 feet to a point, thence North 12°20' West a distance of 332.36 feet to a point, thence North 16°19' West a distance of 98.36 feet more or less to a point on the South right of way line of the Midland Valley Railroad, thence North 73°41' East along said Midland Valley right of way line a distance of 80.0 feet thence South 16°19' East a distance of 101.64 feet to a poing, thence South 11°37' East a distance of 826.01 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.643 acres more or less, all being located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
