August 8, 1914.

The Board of County Commissioners met in their rooms, all members present, and proceeded to audit claims against the County. (See claims.)

County Engineer instructed to act in conjunction with City Engineer in re opening of 15th St.

Upon motion the County Engineer was instructed to act in conjunction with the City Engineer in the opening of Fifteenth Street; that the contract on said work be let to the lowest responsible bidder, the County bearing one half the cost of same upon presentation of claims approved by the County Engineer.

Bids were opened for the construction of bridges Nos. 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, 119 and 120. The following bids were received:

Said Road to be 50 ft wide, 25 ft on each side of the half sec. line. The owners of said land agreeing to deed the said land for road purposes .
