MONDAY, JULY 15th, 1940.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, July 15th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

A petition has been presented by the tax-payers of Parkview Drainage District containing more than twenty per cent of the tax-payers in said district for the appointment of John O. Whitaker as Commissioner, motion by Commissioner Shepard, that John O. Whitaker be appointed Commissioner of Parkview Drainage District. Motion seconded by Commissioner Morley, and upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by Edward F. Jones, Clerk of Court of Common Pleas, for the month of June, 1940, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, that the motion made on May 20th, 1940, authorizing and directing the County Attorney to appeal the judgments rendered by the District Court in the following cases: Application of Morningside Hospital for correction of erroneous assessment-District Court of Tulsa County No. 67312, and The A merican First Trust Company vs. Morningside Hospital, District Court of Tulsa County No. 68407, be and the same is hereby rescinded. Motion seconded by Commissioner Shepard with the following statement: I am seconding the motion for the reason that I think, after due consideration, that it is to the best interests of Tulsa County that these taxes be paid as set out by the order of the District Court and to save the possibility of these taxes becoming a burden to Tulsa County through the re-sale of property for taxes. The City of Tulsa concurs, through its governing board, in this action; also School District No. 22. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Sallee, Aye; Morley, No, for the reason as expressed in the recent motion which I made. Motion carried.
