J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

This being the day set to sell the Caney river bridge to the highest bidder. Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Caney river bridge be sold to A. Pinsker for the sum of \$1,040, same being the highest bid and Geo. Straughn, County Engineer is hereby authorized to prepare a bill of sale to A. Pinsker for the bridge. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by the City of Tulsa and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, covering Part of Lots 6 to 9, Block 20, Berry Addition for the years 1931 to 1942, Inc., be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The minutes of March 1st up to and including March 25th, 1943, were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that they stand approved as read. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that Thelma Lovely, Telephone Operator, be dropped from the payroll as of March 29th, 1943, and that Marguerite Saxon be appointed in her place at a salary of \$130.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
