MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE
THURSDAY, APRIL 28, 1988

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: Lewis Harris, Chairman; John Selph, Member; Melvin C. Rice, Member. Members absent: None. Others present: Clayton Edwards; Leroy Jones, Linda Knowles; Bob Parmele; Ray Hasselman; Mack Bettis; Wayne Carr; Jim Crawley; Terry Hadley; Shannon Patterson.

Lewis Harris, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m., and the following business was transacted:

Jones and Carr presented information supporting Carr's request for a personal computer to perform budgeting functions and word processing. Motion by Selph, seconded by Rice, to approve purchase of Personal System 30 at a cost of \$3,000. Upon roll call: Selph, yes; Rice, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried. (Clerk's Misc. File No. 121883)

Jones and Bettis presented information supporting Assessor's request for IBM Personal System 50 and related equipment to replace a TRS-80 personal computer heretofore used as research and management tool. TRS-80 lacks ability to perform many functions considered today as standard. It is not under maintenance contract and subject to prohibitive repair costs. Motion by Rice, seconded by Selph to approve purchase of Personal System 50 and related equipment for Assessor's CAMA tasks at a cost of \$4,419. Upon roll call: Selph, yes; Rice, yes; Harris, yes.
