MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 15th, 1941.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, September 15th, 1941, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the action of this Board on September 2nd, 1941, re: Water Improvement District No. 9, be and the same is hereby rescinded, upon the recommendation of the County Attorney. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the salary of the Directors of Water Improvement District No. 9 be set at \$20.00 each per month and that the salary of the Clerk-Superintendent be set at \$125.00 per month as of September 15th, 1941, until further order by this Board. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the bond of W. T. Napier, M.D., as Superintendent of the Municipal Hospital, and written by the National Surety Corporation, ^{in the amount of \$2,000} ^{as of July 8, 1941.} be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Fanny C. Edson covering intangible property for the year 1940, be and the same is hereby denied, upon the recommendation of the County Attorney. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
