## CONTRACT

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, By and between the parties hereto that this Contract shall and will be in full force and effect for and during the period of from June 6th.1933 to June 6,1935 and said Contract shall and will be executed and said form shall be transmitted to the Superintendent of Eastern Oklahoma Hospital forthe Insane at Vinita,Oklahoma, and that the copy so transmitted to said Superintendent shall and will be his authority for the delivery of bodies herein provided for, to said party of the first part.
