The above resolution was read in full by the Clerk, and it was moved by Commissioner W. L. North and seconded by Commissioner Ed Dalton that the same be adopted as read. Thereupon the question was put to a vote, the following members voting "Aye".

The Chairman declared the motion carried and the resolution and order adopted as read.

The Affidavit of Erroneous Assessment of the Oklahoma Glazed Cement and Pipe Company, covering the 1919 and 1920 taxes part of the SE of NW4 of Section two (2), township Nineteen (19) north, Range twelve (12) east, was presented and read before the Board, and it appearing to this Board that there is an error in said assessment by reason of an error in assessing. It is therefore, by this Board ordered, that the said assessment be reduced on a valuation of \$11200.00.

The Affidavit of Erroneous assessment of Ava D. Hannon on the Hannan Grocery Company, 1003 South Peoria Avenue, was presented and considered by the Board, and upon motion duly made and seconded \$1000.00 was stricken from the valuation of said property account, clerical error.

The affidavit or erroneous assess ment of the F. S. Miller Lumber Company on the North half of lot 7 block 18 Original Town, was presented to the Board, and the Board being fully advised in the premises, the entire valuation of the north half of said lot was stricken on account of same being the property of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company's property.

C. A. Sanderson presented an affidavit of erroneous assessment covering the 1917, 1918 and 1919 taxes on Lots 6 and 7 Block 3, Beuna Vista, which were owned by the Tulsa City Park Board, hence non-taxable. It is therefore ordered by this Board that said assessment be and the same is hereby stricken from the records of the County Treasurer.

There being no further business coming before the Board for consideration on motion duly made and seconded, the Board adjourned to June 30th, 1921.
