R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to establish by resolution certain fees to be charged by the Sheriff of Tulsa County, and

WHEREAS, said Board of County Commissioners have made a careful study of the fees now charged by said sheriff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and he is hereby allowed the sum of Eight and 50/100 (\$8.50) Dollars for mileage and expenses in transporting or transferring prisoners, or persons found to be insane, to the state institutions located at Vinita and Taft, Oklahoma.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in transportation of prisoners from Tulsa County to any other state institution, or the transportation of prisoners from any point to Tulsa County, the Sheriff of Tulsa County is hereby allowed an amount equal to the minimum railroad fare for each passenger, and in addition thereto all other expense or expenses, for which receipts are to be furnished.
