Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the County Highway Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund, in the amount of \$17,235.86, and the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund, in the amount of \$6,382.18, be and the same is hereby approved, and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit them to the Excise Board for their consideration.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the County Clerk be and he is hereby ordered and directed to publish Notice to Bidders for the furnishing of materials and the performance of all labor required in the erection and completion of the Booker T. Washington High School Building, as required by law. Bids will be received until 10:00 O'clock A. M., November 22, 1948. The official publication to be placed in the Tulsa Legal News, and appropriate short notices to be placed in the Tulsa Daily World and Tulsa Tribune.

Hearing was held in the matter of the application of John E. Archer for the acquisition of a roadway across the land of Laura B. Turley, now Morrison. It is found, determined and adjudged that the necessity for a roadway extending from the Northwest corner of the John E. Archer ten acres directly northward to 46th Street is found to exist; therefore, motion was made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the road be built.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that Mr. A. C. Owen be placed back to work as County Health Inspector as of November 1, 1948.
