

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 18th, 1941.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report of J. M. Baker, Ditch Commissioner of Parkview Drainage District, having been received and filed by the Commission, that the time and place of hearing on said report be fixed at 10:00 o'clock A.M., on the 20th day of October, 1941, in the office of the Board of County Commissioners in the Tulsa County courthouse and that notice of such hearing be given as required by law. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
