WHEREAS, The Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to EMMA WHITFIELD of the land hereinafter described, of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of \$125.35 the following described land, to-wit:

AND, WHEREAS, the sale of said land by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the Compiled Oklahoma Statutes of 1921 and amended by Chapter 123 of the Session laws of Oklahoma, for 1925, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him as tax re-sale, and
