

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County has been allocated certain Funds from the tax levied by House Bill No. 470 of the Twentieth Legislature to be used to match Federal Funds for the construction of Secondary roads in Tulsa County, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners are desirous of having the following roads constructed in Tulsa County:-

No. 1. Four miles of grading, drainage and surfacing on the Willow Springs Road. Beginning two miles North and one mile East of Bixby and continuing East four miles, and the surfacing on one mile of the Willow Springs Road, beginning two miles North of Bixby running East from U. S. Highway No. 64.

No. 2. Intermediate surfacing on approximately six miles of County Road beginning three miles south of Bixby and extending Southwesterly (This is for the surfacing of Projects FAS-S-320(1) and FAS-S-321(1)).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Highway Commission of Oklahoma is requested to submit plans, specifications and estimates to the Public Roads Administration for approval and participation, and when the approval of the Public Roads Administration is received, that the Highway Commissioner of Oklahoma is hereby requested to proceed with the advertising, opening of Bids and other formalities in accordance with the usual procedure of letting of Contracts for State Highway Construction.
