

Section 5. That by reason of Tulsa County being without adequate free fair facilities, it is deemed and is hereby declared necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare that lands be purchased and improved and buildings constructed for free fair purposes without delay.

WHEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication.
