John Burton be and he is hereby appointed Superintendent of Roads as of September 22nd,

1941, at a salary of \$200.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that Cecil Stubblefield be appointed Grader man or Caterpillar Driver in the Highway Department at a salary of \$140.00 per month as of September 22nd, 1941, and that Roy Henley be appointed Construction man in the Highway Department at a salary of \$135.00 per month as of September 22nd, 1941.
