MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 1994

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County met at the hour of 9:30 a.m. with the following members present: Lewis Harris, Chairman; John Selph, Member; Robert N. Dick, Member; and Joan Hastings, County Clerk.

Lewis Harris, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m. and the following business was transacted:

Lyndall Cole, Tulsa County Deputy Sheriff, presented Commissioner Dick with the first annual Oklahoma DARE Role Model of the Year award.

Lyndall Cole and Tim Albin, Deputies of the Tulsa County Sheriff's office, were present and requested the Commissioners' support for a 1/2 cent sales tax to fund additional jail space, raise level of Sheriff's deputies salaries to a comparable level with other law enforcement colleagues within this region and the creation and implementation of a School Resource Officer program in Tulsa County schools. Commissioners stated they are supportive of the request, but feel there needs to be a study made to find the exact amount needed. They thanked all the Deputies attending and stated they hoped to get this subject before the voters of Tulsa County in 1995.

Chairman stated a five minutes recess will be taken at this time.

Meeting reconvened at 10:10 a.m.
