

Estimates to be made

(9) Make a report in writing of all their doings and findings under this order and file same with the County Clerk of this County.

(10) To make a profile of the said drains and plat of the whole work.

(11) And that they make a schedule showing,

(A) All of the lots and lands.

(B) All public or corporate roads and Rail Roads.

(C) And the names of the owners and residence of owners that will be damaged or benefitted or condemned by or for the said drains.

(D) And the damages or benefit and the amount of same to each tract of forty acres or less.

(12) That they make a separate estimate of the cost of location and construction and apportion the same to each tract in proportion to the benefits or damages that may result to each.

(13) And they shall specify the manner and time in which said drain shall be completed.

(14) And they shall further specify the number and dimensions of flood-gates, water ways, farm crossings and bridges necessary for said drains and shall note County and Township lines and Rail Road Crossings.

(18) That the plat above referred to by them made shall be large enough to show distinctly and intelligently

(a) Meanderings of said drains.

(b) Boundary lines of each tract of land crossed.

(c) Each road or Rail-Road to be benefitted or taxed.

(d) Name of each owner of land or owner of interest in land.

(e) Name of each authority or Company having in charge or controlling each public or corporate road or Rail Road.

(f) The distance in feet through each tract or parcel of land.

(g) Such other matter as the viewers or surveyor may deem material.

(19) That the profile above referred to and by them to be filed show

(A) The surface and grade line or grades if any fixed.

(20) And that the said viewers and surveyor file their itemized bill of costs made in the discharge of their above described duties
