WHEREASm rge Highway Department is in need of an automobile and has found that a trade or exchange can be made with Fred Jones (Ford Dealer) for a 1941 Ford 112" Pickup, Motor Number 6700680, in exchange for the Chevrolet Sedan and a further consideration of payment by Tulsa County to Fred Jones (Ford Dealer) the sum of Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$650.00)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to transfer title to the aforesaid Chevrolet Sedan and deliver same to Fred Jones (Ford Dealer) in exchange for the said Ford 112" pickup when accompanied by a proper transfer of title to Tulsa County, and that the County Highway Department be authorized to draw a claim to the Fred Jones (Ford Dealer) in the sum of Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$650.00), payable from Account Number 8, designated as "Furchase of Tools, Trucks & Equipment" of the County Highway Department Account of the Cash Fund.
