

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, TO EXECUTE AN EASEMENT COVERING CERTAIN LANDS HEREINAFTER SET OUT, TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A SANITARY SEWER LINE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the United States of America desires to construct or have constructed a sanitary sewer line and desires a permanent easement and right-of-way, 33 feet in width, in, over upon and across the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, with right of ingress and egress to and from the same at all times, with authority to construct, operate, maintain, repair, patrol and remove a sanitary sewer line, together with the right to cut and remove such vegetation and obstructions within the limits of the right-of-way as may be necessary for construction, operation and maintenance thereof, to-wit:

A strip of land 33 feet in width, across the County highway between Sections Twenty-two (22) and Twenty-three (23), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian, and more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at a point 883 feet, more or less, North and 33 feet, more or less, West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-two (22); thence in an Easterly direction for a distance of 66 feet, more or less, to a point on the East right-of-way line of said County road,

and

WHEREAS, the granting of said right-of-way for said purposes will be beneficial to the War effort of the United States of America and will not be detrimental to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be, and they are hereby authorized to execute a permanent easement and right-of-way covering the lands and premises hereinabove described, with right of ingress and egress to and from the same at all times, to construct, operate, maintain, patrol, repair and remove a sanitary sewer line, together with the right to cut and remove such vegetation and obstructions within the limits of the right-of-way as may be necessary for construction, operation and maintenance as aforesaid.

Section 2. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, by reason whereof this Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

ADOPTED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately, this 4th day of December, 1944.
