A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the County Attorney be instructed to make settlement of the cases pending for taxes paid under protest on a cash basis or on a basis of 75%, or in such manner as is in the opinion of the County Attorney to the best interest of Tulsa County. Motion carried.

Moved by F. M. Wooden and seconded by W. L. North that the County Clerk be instructed to notify Mr. Lewis Cline that unless the shortage disclosed by the audit is settled on or before the 5th day of July, 1921, that said matter will be referred to the County Attorney for legal action. Motion carried.

The duputy State Examiner and Inspector, Ed O. Cassidy, presented for the consideration of the Board Volumns Two and Three of the special audit heretofore ordered by this Board. Volumns Two and Three have been approved by the State Examiner's and Inspector's Office, and a correct copy thereof filed with the Governor of the State of Oklahoma.

Volumn One has heretofore been filed andapproved, and settlements made of the amounts due thereunder, and it is moved by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the matters connected with this audit as shown by volumns two and three, which volumns are approved and filed in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same are hereby referred tomthe County Attorney for proper legal action for the collection of any amounts certified as being due in said volumns of said audit.
