Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the application of the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company for the use of certain highways of the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be approved, and the Chairman authorized to execute the contract. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA

The undersigned, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and qualified to do business therein for the furnishing of light, heat and power by electricity and not being an Interstate Pipe Line Company, hereby requests the consent of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to use the highways of the county herein-after designated, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining poles, or posts along or across the same, to sustain its wires and fixtures for the transmission and sales of electricity for light, heat and power purposes, as provided by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

The highways proposed to be used under this application are wholly within Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and are more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of Section 20 T17N-R13E and running south along the east side of Section 20-T17N-R13E a distance of approximately 3900 feet.

Said right of way to include the right to cross all highways and roads intersecting any part of the route above indicated, and to include the right, where necessary, to cross from one side of the road to the other to avoid interference with existing telephone lines, and the right to erect and maintain where necessary, stubs and guy wires. Said line will be built, if consent is granted, as near to the side of the road as practicable, and not more than four (4) feet from the edge of the Highway right of way; said line to be constructed in accordance with the standards prescribed by the State of Oklahoma through Corporation Commissioner's Order Number 16061, and in such manner as will not obstruct or impede traffic on said highway.

The Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company will remove its line to such other location along said highway as may be designated by the County Engineer, in the event such removal is necessary on account of improvement of highways.

The Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company will place all poles along the highway and particularly at intersections of the highway in such a manner that there will be no hazard to traffic and to save Tulsa County from any damage of whatsoever nature or kind that might occur to either public or private property at such time as said work is performed.
