

FRIDAY, JULY 1st, 1921.

Pursuant to adjournment the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, met in the office of the County Clerk at the hour of ten (10) o'clock A. M. Present in person: F. M. Wooden, Chairman, W. L. North and Ed Dalton Members, and O. D. Lawson, County Clerk, and Clerk of the Board.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, who announced that the meeting was open for any business that might properly come before it, and the Clerk presented the bids for the construction of separate school buildings at Keystone and Bixby, which bids were duly considered by the Board, thereupon

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the SOUTHERN MILL & MANUFACTURING COMPANY of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be awarded the contract for the Separate School Building at Keystone and Bixby in accordance with the following proposals, respectively:

Gentlemen:-

We propose to deliver and erect a One Room Sectional School Building of 16x20 dimensions and to have a front porch 6x10, to be used as a Colored School at Keystone, and as per the following: "One 16 x20 sectional building erected on foundation supplied by District, Outside walls of building to be covered with regular matched novelty siding and inside walls to be finished with Beaver Board. Windows to have cut up top sash and to be fitted with weights and pulleys and sash locks. Doors to be fitted with hardware and to be three panel one light doors. Roofing material in sectional units to be matched and covered with three ply slate coated roofing. All inside and outside exposed parts to be painted one coat of paint before being erected. Inside moulds to be of attractive design and all trim to be of good quality yellow pine. Brick flue built on stand and to be of regulation size for coal heaters. All sills, floor joist outside wall sections to be made with out weathertight interlocking joints. Ceiling to be panelled. Building to be fastened together with heavy bolts and screws to enable the same to be moved without loss of material. All for the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty Five (\$825.00) Dollars, delivered and set up at Keystone.

Extra for second coat of paint inside and out (\$40.00)

Delivery can be made immediately and building ready for occupancy within five days after foundation is ready.
