The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County met in regular session at 1 P.M. in County Clerk's office. Present W.L. North & Geo Mc Keekan. On motion of Board J. N. Sippy was rebated 4⁶⁶ and warrant ordered drawn for same erroneous assessment on Personal Taxes. The Lancaster Sanders Co. was allowed \$60⁰⁰ rebate on Personal Tax it being shown that their capital stock was erroneously assessed. The Official Bonds of Martin Schutter, Treasurer Lynn Lane Township J. N. Allspaugh, Clerk Wekiva Township, James W. Wall, Constable Tulsa Township, John Batcher Assessor Dawson Township, J. F. Hoos, Public Weigher, W. A. Whitlock, Assessor Town of Owasso, Harry E. Baith, Clerk Bowles Township, was on motion approved. Wm Sample was appointed Justice of The Peace, Ged Fork Township vice Gideon Hunt who has removed from the Township. Brown El Ellingwood made a showing that Leon Lancel Head of their cattle was assessed in Texas thus making an erroneous assessment. The Clerk was instructed to correct Tax Rolls rebating them to the above amount on motion of Board. The Clerk was instructed to divide John Archer's Personal Property, separating improvements on lands from other property listed on motion of Board. On motion of Board Twenty Five Dollars was appropriated to The Holmes Home & Hospital for care of Bessie Van Lane out of Poor and Sickness Fund. It being shown by the Assessor's Rolls that C. W. Rogers was assessed 2000⁰⁰ Bank stock when the Skiatook Bank was assessed on the same stock therefore making an erroneous assessment to that amount. The Clerk was instructed to correct error. On motion W. S. Mayfield was appointed constable of Tulsa Township.
