O R D E R.

ON this 5th day of January, 1931, the matter of the Petition of J C York, for permission to extend service wires along and across certain highways in said County, came up before the Board of County Commissioners for hearing and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Petitioner be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by the following description:

"From Section Eight (8), Township 18 N., R 13 E., to Section Nine (9), Township 18 N., R 13 E., crossing North and South Section line on County Highway at a point approximately Three Hundred (300') feet south of Section corner of Sections 4, 5, 8 & 9, T 18 N., Range 13 E.

AND, it further appearing that the said line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted the above petitioner, and the same is hereby granted him to use as much of the highways as above designated.

Motion was made by Mr. Hedgecock, seconded by Mr. North, that MR. M J McNULTY be and he is hereby appointed as Member of the Tulsa State Fair Board for a term of Six (6) Years to succeed Mr. N R Graham. Motion was declared carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Dickey, seconded by Mr. North, that Mr. JOHN T KRAMER be and he is hereby re-appointed to succeed himself as a Member of the Tulsa, State Fair Board for a term of Six (6) Years. All voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Dickey, that Justice of the Peace Merrill S Bernard be and he is hereby instructed to turn his records and all things pertaining to the office of Justice of the Peace over to M L Brown, his successor. Upon roll call the following vote was cast: North, Yes, Hedgecock, No and Dickey Yes. Motion receiving a majority of the unanimous vote, was declared carried.
